DAILY PREPARATIONS

DAY 1 - Read Esther 1 & 2. It's a lot ... but you can do it! Write down 3 words each to describe Ahasuerus, Vashti, Mordecai, Esther. Write down 3 words that describe you!

DAY 2 - Read Esther 3 & 4. What does it mean to you to be at YOUR Kings' gate?

DAY 3 - Read Esther 5. Go back through the first 5 chapters of Esther and underline the phrase every time Mordecai is at the king's gate.

DAY 4 - Read Esther 6. Is there someone with whom you are struggling in relationship? What can you do to honor this person today?

DAY 5 - Read Esther 7. Go back through Esther 6 & 7 and underline the phrase every time Mordecai is in the king's gate.

DAY 6 - Read Proverbs 31. Underline the phrases that describe Queen Esther. Circle the verses that describe you. What do you and Esther have in common?
