DAILY PREPARATIONS

DAY 1- Read Esther Chapter 7. As you contemplate the story of Esther, what is at the heart of Haman's attempt to destroy the Jewish people? What is at the heart of Esther and Mordecai's attempt to save the Jewish people?

DAY 2 - Read Esther Chapter 8. Why do you believe that the name of God is not mentioned in this story? List three instances where you saw the fingerprint of God in the story of Esther.

DAY 3 - Read Hebrews 12:1-3 and Psalm 46. How does knowing that you are surrounded by a great cloud of witnesses inspire your faith? What does it mean to "fix your eyes on Jesus"? Be practical. How do these verses say that we can "not grow weary and lose heart"?

DAY 4 - Read Psalm 47. List 2 instances in the Book of Esther that you see the battle for worship taking place. Where does the battle for worship take place in your life?

DAY 5 - Read Psalm 48. Which verse particularly speaks to you? Underline it and pray it out loud.

DAY 6 - Read Psalm 49. Which verse particularly speaks to you? Underline it and pray it out loud.

DAY 7 - Read Psalm 50. Is there a verse in this Psalm that is difficult for you to understand? Spend some time thinking about it and praying over it. Ask the Holy Spirit to show you what it means.
