GOING DEEPER QUESTIONS:

DAY 1: Read John 10: 1 - 21. Write down 10 characteristics of an abundant life. Why does the devil work so hard to steal that life from us? How does he try to steal it? How can you insure that he does not steal it from you?

DAY 2: Read I Timothy 6:6-21. If God were to give you a large sum of money, what would you do with it? What is God telling you to do with the money that you have right now?

DAY 3: Read I Corinthians 9:1-10, 24 - 27. Are you sowing a seed into the Gospel that will bring a harvest back into your life? Do you enjoy your possessions or do

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you feel guilty about them? Do you need an attitude adjustment in any area of your life?

DAY 4: Read Hebrews 11:1 – 29. Make a list of about 5 men and women in the Bible who you consider heroes or heroines. After each name, list a characteristic that causes you to admire that person.

DAY 5: Read Hebrews 11:30 – 40. Who are some heroes or heroines of the faith that you have either read about, heard about or have known personally? Make a list of about 5 and, again, list a characteristic of why you admire that person.

DAY 6: Read I I Peter 1:1 – 15. Write down, in your own words, a definition of the following words: diligence, faith, moral excellence, knowledge, self-control, perseverance, godliness, brotherly kindness, love. Which of those words describe you?

DAY 7: Read Psalm 1. According to verse 2, what should we delight in? How do you delight in this? Give practical examples.
