GOING DEEPER QUESTIONS:

DAY ONE: Read Jeremiah 32:38-41 and Psalm 34. Choose 2 or 3 verses from these passages that especially speak to your heart. Underline them in your Bible. Write them out in a journal. Meditate on them this week.

DAY TWO: Read Genesis 2:7 and Genesis 1:27 & 28. In your opinion, what is the breath of God today? What does it mean to be blessed by the God of Creation?

DAY THREE: Read Genesis 12: 1 & 2 and Genesis 17:1-6. What do habits, heart attitudes or relationships do you need to leave behind in order to love the eternal and not the temporary? How have you ever felt the breath of God upon your life?

DAY FOUR: Read Exodus 19:3-7, Exodus 33:11 and Exodus 34:34 & 35. List 3 things that you learn about Moses from reading these verses; also list three things that you learn about God from reading these verses.

DAY FIVE: Read the 23rd Psalm; Read Isaiah 62:2 - 5; Read Jeremiah 9:23 & 24. According to the 23rd Psalm, what are 5 things that the Shepherd does for you? According to the verses in Isaiah, how does God see you? According to the verses in Jeremiah, what should we boast about?

DAY SIX: Read Luke 1:26-38. How does this story reveal another aspect of the romance between God and His people? Find the specific words that Mary speaks in response to God's wooing her. Pray those words over your life today.

DAY SEVEN: Read Acts 4:1-13. Do you believe that the people in your world recognize you as having been with Jesus? How is this possible?
