## Lesson 1

II Chronicles 25:1–2 "He did right in the sight of the Lord, yet not with a whole heart."

**Nugget** # 1 – Obey the Lord with a whole heart; give Him your whole heart!

II Chronicles 25:5

**Nugget # 2** – Increased strength and fighting power is the blessing of giving to God your whole heart!

II Chronicles 25:6 – Valiant = chayil = strength, power, might, efficient, rich

Nugget #3 – It is dangerous to partner with those who reject or ignore the most powerful Person in our lives when we fight our battles.

II Chronicles 25: 7 & 8 -

**Nugget** # 4 – God has the power to help and to bring down!

Power = koach - the ability or power to do anything!

II Chronicles 25:9a

**Nugget** # 5 – You can't afford to partner with what the world offers!

**Nugget of Pure Gold**: "And the man of God answered, 'The Lord has MUCH MORE to give you than this."

Much more = rabah rabah = multiplication and greatness A number too large to count

I John 5:4 – "For whatever is born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has overcome the world: our faith."

Overcomes = nikos = conquer

II Corinthians 4:9

Romans 8:37 – In all these things we are MUCH MORE than conquerors through Him Who loved us."

"More than conquerors" = hupernikos

"Much more than conquerors" = hupernikos hupernikos

huper= over, above, beyond
