### **DAILY DISCIPLINES OF GREATNESS**

**DAY 1** - Read I Samuel 1:1-8. Describe Peninnah in 3 words. Describe Hannah in 3 words. Why does the Bible use the word “rival” to describe Peninnah? Are you more like Hannah or Peninnah? What has been your greatest disappointment in life? Read Psalm 17.

**DAY 2** - Read I Samuel 1:9-19. What made the difference for Hannah? Why is it important to worship before your circumstances change? Describe Eli in 3 words. Describe Elkenah in 3 words. Read Psalm 18:1-24.

**DAY 3** - Read I Samuel 1:20-28. Go back through I Samuel 1 and underline the words, “worship”, “sacrifice”, “pray” or “minister” or any form of these words. How important are these 4 verbs in your life? Do you do them daily? Read Psalm 18:25-end.

**DAY 4** - Read I Samuel 2:1-11. This is a song that Hannah is singing at a very challenging moment in her life. What have been the 3 most challenging moments in your life? Have you responded emotionally or with a song of praise? Read Psalm 19.

**DAY 5** - Read I Samuel 3:1-10. What is the difference between the place where Eli slept and the place where Samuel slept? Do you tend to fill your life with your own things or with an awareness of the presence of God? How will this make a difference in your life? Read Psalm 20.

**DAY 6** - Read Psalm 21. Underline all the words that turn your heart toward worship. Verse 2 talks about “heart’s desire”. What is your heart’s desire? Write it out.

**DAY 7** - Read Psalm 22. Underline 5 verses that really speak to your soul. How does verse 5 say that we are to deal with disappointment? Verse 30 talks about the coming generation. Make a list of the coming generation in your family and pray over them today.
