DAILY FOCUS

DAY 1 - Read II Chronicles 20:1 - 13. What are some of the ways that you have fought battles in the past? DAY 4 - Read Psalm 7. What does it mean that the Lord is your shield? What does it mean to take refuge in the Lord? Underline verse 17 and spend some time in worship. **DAY 5** - Read Psalm 8. What is your definition of the word "majestic"? According to verses 4-6, what is man's position in relationship to God and the angels?

DAY 6 - Read Psalm 9. Underline every word that means "rejoice", "worship" or "praise". Why is worshipping out loud important?
