DAILY FOCUS

DAY 1 - Read Matthew 14:1-12. Who is the dearest person to you who has died? What was your response to this tragedy? How did God comfort you?

DAY 2 - Read Matthew 14:13 - 21. What is your area of lack in life? How have you learned to deal with lack from this story? Read verse 19 again. What did Jesus do?

DAY 3 - Read Matthew 14:22-33. What storm are you currently in? List 3 things that you have learned from this story.

DAY 4 - Read Mark 6:45 - 52. Compare it to the same story in Matthew 14:22-33. What was your last miracle? Thank God for it today!

DAY 5 - Read Psalms 11 & 12. Underline 3 verses that minister to you in these 2 chapters. How does the Psalmist describe the words of the Lord in Psalm 12:6 & 7?

DAY 6 - Read Psalms 13 & 14. Underline 3-4 verses in these 2 Psalms that particularly minister to you. How was the Psalmist feeling in Psalm 13?

DAY 7 - Read Psalms 15 & 16. Read Psalm 15:5-11 again. Where can you discover joy? What does verse 6 mean to you?
